HNGU LL.M. Ordinance and Regulations w.e.f. 2018

Subjects: Master of Laws (LL.M) Criminal Law, Business law, Human Rights Group offered by Faculty of Law

(ડીગ્રી/અભ્યાસક્રમના એલીજબીટીરૂલ્સ અને મેરીટ પદ્ધતિ, ટાઈબ્રેકરૂલ્સ)

Level : Post Graduate

Program mode: Regular

Rule. LL.M-1: Eligibility:

(1) A Candidate will be eligible for admission to a course leading to the Degrees of Master of Laws (LL.M.) must have passed LL.B. (Three Years LL.B), have passed Five Years Integrated Law Degree Course from University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State Legislature or an equivalent National Institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or a Foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence and has secured **minimum 50% of the total marks.**

(2) A candidate who has passed LL.M. examination from any other University shall be eligible for admission only to the First semester of LL.M. Programme of this University as a fresh student and the Grades/Credits/marks obtained in LL.M. outside Hemchandracharaya North Gujarat University will not be considered for award of LL.M. Degree.

(3) A candidate who has obtained LL.M. degree of Hemchandracharaya North Gujarat University in one area of specialization will be eligible for admission in First semester of LL.M. with another area of specialization only as a fresh student. Grades/Marks/Credits obtained in LL.M. in previous area of specialization will not be considered or carried forward nor will any exemption in any paper will be given.

(4) The registration of the candidate in the LL.M. programme shall be normally for a period of five years from the date of registration. However, the Vice Chancellor may extend the period by one or more years on behalf of the Executive Council.

(5) In case the student is unable to pass the LL.M. programme till the expiry of the duration of registration will have to re-register in the LL.M. programme as a fresh student as per clause (1) above.

(6) In a case, if a candidate drops out of the programme voluntarily for any reason whatsoever and opts to join any other programme by obtaining a Transfer and/or Migration Certificate, the registration of the candidate in the LL.M. programme shall stand automatically cancelled.

Rule. LL.M.-2: Admission Procedure

The admission to the LL.M. programme shall be made following such procedure as may be prescribed by the Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University from time to time. The General Rules and Instructions for P.G. admissions prescribed by the University shall be followed.

Rule LL.M.-3: Reservation

The rules of reservation in LL.M. admissions as in force set by the Government of Gujarat, the University and any other competent authority shall be followed:-

For the purpose of admission, the seats shall be reserved for the candidates who are of Gujarat origin and falling under the following categories and in following proportion, namely-

Reservation of Seats

Scheduled Castes: 7 %

Scheduled Tribes: 15%

Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC): 27%

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) 10% supernumerary as per BCI letter.

Candidates who have passed Qualifying Examination from other than Gujarat Board and Central Board School outside Gujarat State : 5%

Physically Handicapped (Physically

Rule.LL.M.-4: Intake

The maximum Intake capacity in each section of a Department of University shall not be more than 60-Business Group, 60-Criminal Group and 20-Human Rights Group in department of Law and 20 students in each GIA affiliated Law Colleges. However, the Vice Chancellor may grant permission on behalf of the Executive Council to

admit more student in a section as and when the need arise and the Vice Chancellor deem fit to do 50.

Rule.LL.M.-5: Conditions for eligibility to appear in End Semester External Examination (1) A candidate shall be eligible to appear in the End Semester External examination conducted by the University provided that the candidate has secured not less than 70% of the total attendance arrived at by taking into account the total number of lectures engaged, in each and every paper of the semester. A Relaxation in the requirement for semester attendance will be allowed on account of maternity or any other medical reason deemed sufficient by the Head of the Department of University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college. The candidate shall become eligible to appear in the End Semester External Examination for the semester in which such relaxation is granted to the candidate.

(2) Candidates desirous of appearing at any End Semester External Examinations must forward their application in the prescribed form to the Registrar of the University through the Head of the Department of University/ P.G. Centre of the affiliated college on or before the date prescribed for by the University along with the examination fees as prescribed by the University.

Rule. LL.M.-6: Eligibility for award of LL.M. Degree

The duration of the course of LL.M. Degree shall be of two academic years comprising of four semesters. LL.M. degree shall be awarded to the candidate upon successfully passing all the four semesters before the expiry of the duration of LL.M. registration.

Rule. LL.M.-7: Anti Ragging and Gender Problem

The Head of the Department of University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college shall have to take appropriate measures against Ragging and Gender problems. In case of occurrence of any such incident, the student(s) who have committed such act(s) shall be dealt with seriously and appropriate stringent actions shall be taken by the Head of the Department of University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college by observing the Principles of Natural Justice. The Head of the Department of University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college may appoint a committee to inquire into such matter(s). The committee so constituted will submit its report to the Head of the Department of

University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college who in turn will forward the same with his comment thereupon to the Registrar of the University for taking further necessary action in the said matter.

LL.M. REGULATIONS

Rule LL.M. 1: Course Structure

(1) The LL.M. Programme shall be full-time post-graduate programme of TwoYear duration comprising of Four Semesters. The medium of instruction shall be Gujarati & English. The student may, however, write their examination in English/Gujarati/Hindi as per the University provisions. Nonetheless, the language of answer once opted by the student will not be changed during the entire programme of LL.M.

(2) The LL.M. Programme shall comprise of four semesters with Semester-I and Semester-II in the First Academic Year of the Programme and Semester-III and Semester-IV in the Second Academic Year of the Programme. The Semester-I and Semester-III (odd semesters) shall ordinarily be from July to November/December and the Semester-II and Semester-IV (Even semesters) from December to April/May.

(3) (i) The LL.M. programme shall consist of total 80 credits and the students will be required to earn stipulated credits per course per semester for obtaining the Degree of LL.M. as shown below:

(ii) The credit per course is determined as One Credit equivalent to One Hour of study for the duration of 15 Weeks per Semester with not less than 24 Lecture/Practical hours per week.

(iii) The workload of a faculty shall be determined considering the total number of Lecture/Practical hours of study.

(4) There will be different elective areas of specialization as per the syllabus of the respective group. The University, however, reserves the right to admit admissions to respective LL.M. (P.G.) Centres on the

basis of adequacy of teaching and other requisite infrastructural facilities. The University reserves the right to offer new areas of specialization and/or withdraw the existing areas of specialization. A candidate can opt for any of the Elective Groups of Specialization offered by the University for admission. However, the admission into one Elective Group of Specialization shall remain final till the completion of the LL.M. Programme and that the change of Elective Group of Specialisation will not be allowed throughout the LL.M. Programme.

(5) The LL.M. programme shall comprise of following types of papers/courses:

(As per Annexure -1)

(i) Core courses: Seven (07) Core Courses (Papers) will be common for all the Elective Groups of Specialization which shall consist of 4 credits each.

(ii) Elective Course: Four (04) Elective Course (Papers) for each of the Elective Groups of Specialization which shall consist of 4 credits each.

(iii) Practical/Project Course: Two (02) Practical Courses of 4 credits each comprising of Doctrinal Research, Non-Doctrinal Research, Clinical Research Report and Class-room Teaching, each carrying 4 credits, shall be compulsory for all the Elective Groups of Specialization Groups.

(ii) Dissertation: A Dissertation shall be compulsory for all the Elective Groups of Specialization in Semester-IV which shall consist of 08 credits in which there will be 05 credits for Dissertation, credits for Presentation and 03 credits for Viva Voce.

Rule LL.M. 2: Assessment and Scheme of Examination

(1) The Core and Elective paper/course will have weightage of 100 marks each and shall be assessed on basis of an External End Semester Examination (University examination) in every semester.

(2) The Practical/Project Courses will have a weightage of 100 marks each which shall comprise of the components viz. Doctrinal Research, Non-Doctrinal Research, Class room Teaching and Clinical Research wherein each component will have a weightage of 50 marks.

(3) For Dissertation of 200 marks, the assessment weightage shall be 150 marks for written thesis and 50 marks for External Viva Voce.

(4) The Dissertation will carry out throughout the two years of LL.M. The Dissertation shall be prepared and submitted by the candidates at the end of fourth Semester which shall be evaluated Internally (i.e. by the person who are serving in the same Department of university/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college) and Externally (i.e. by the person not serving in the same Department of University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college)

Rule LL.M. 3: Carrying forward the Semesters& Exemption

Rules for carrying/granting the semesters are given below:

(1) A candidate must have at 70% of attendance in the each semester of the LL.M. Programme and shall have satisfactory performance in class participation, seminar, and/or assignment of each paper/course, if any. However, a candidate who fails to put in at least 40% of the aggregate attendance in a Semester will have to take re-admission in the same Semester.

(2) In case a candidate fails to clear any one course/all courses in the First Semester, he/she shall be allowed to continue to proceed to the Second Semester provided that the candidate has successfully kept his/her term of the First Semester.

(3) The candidate shall be allowed to proceed to the Third Semester only after successfully clearing all the papers/courses of the First and Second Semesters.

(4) In case a candidate fails to clear any one course/all courses in the Third Semester, he/she shall be allowed to continue to proceed to the Fourth Semester provided that the candidate has successfully kept his/her term of the Third Semester.

(5) The candidate shall be eligible for the award of LL.M. Degree after successfully passing all papers/courses of Semesters I, II, III & IV. The candidate will be allowed to appear in the respective End-Semester Examination during validity of his/her LL.M. registration.

(6) If a candidate fails to get minimum 36 marks out of 100 marks in any paper/course in the First/Third Semester of LL.M. Programme at the Semester End Examination, he/she has to again appear and pass

only those courses) separately or along with the Second/Fourth Semester End Semester Examination as the case may be. If such a candidate does not clear course(s) of the First/ Third Semester with minimum of 36 marks out of 100 marks (with 48% aggregate in a Semester) at the End Semester Examination, the result of the End Semester Examination of the Second /Fourth Semester shall be declared as Fail. However, it will be permissible for the candidate to appear for all the papers/courses of First/Third Semesters again. A candidate is eligible to get admission in the Third Semester only after successfully clearing Semester I and Semester II.

(7) If a candidate obtains minimum 36% marks in all the papers/courses of any Semester but fails to score aggregate 48% marks in that Semester, he/she will be given Exemption only in those papers/courses of the Semester in which he/she has obtained 48% (48 marks out of 100 marks) or more and that the marks obtained by him/her in such paper(s)/course(s) will be carried forward. If a candidate waives to exercise his/her option of Exemption, he/she will be permitted to appear in all the papers/courses of a Semester. Moreover, once a candidate opts for Exemption, he/she shall not be allowed to revert.

(8) In the cases of Dissertation wherein the Candidate who has secured at least 48% marks (96 marks out of 200 marks) in Dissertation, the marks so obtained shall be carried forward till the expiry of his/her LL.M. registration. However, if the candidate fails to secure 48% marks in the Dissertation, he/she shall have to submit the Dissertation a fresh in the subsequent Academic Year during the validity of his/her registration, and that his/her term granted have not lapsed.

(9) The University Rules with regard to gracing of marks shall be followed.

(10) The calculation of SGPA and CGPA shall be followed as per the University System for P.G. Programmes after taking into consideration the aggregate marks obtained by a candidate in all the Papers/Courses, Practical/Project Courses along with the Dissertation, Presentation and Viva voce taken together.

(11) A separate Result Sheet shall be issued to a Candidate for each Semester and at the end of successfully clearing all the Four

semesters, a cumulative Result sheet will be issued showing the CGPA and equivalent percentage obtained by a candidate.

(12) A candidate failing in any of the Semester Examination and passes the same by the Fourth Semester, such attempt will be considered as First Attempt.

Rule.LL.M. 4: Standard of Passing & Award of Class

(1) To Pass the Semester Examination, a Candidate must obtain-

(i) at least 36% marks in each paper/course at the University Examination and

(ii) 48% of the total marks obtainable in the aggregate of all the papers/courses.

(iii) at least 48% marks in each Practical/Project Papers/courses and 48% marks in Dissertation which shall be carried forward till the expiry of his/her LL.M. Registration.

Award of Class:

The Candidate shall be awarded Class on the basis of CGPA as per the Seven or Ten PointScale Grading System or any other grading system followed by the University for its P.G. Programmes and accordingly, the following Class be awarded:

(1) Those of the successful candidates who obtain 48% or more but less than 50% marks in the total of the aggregate of Semester-1 to Semester-IV of LL.M. Examinations taken together will be placed in **PASS CLASS**.

(ii) Those of the successful candidates who obtain 50% or more but less than 60% marks in the total of the aggregate of Semester-I to Semester-IV of LL.M. Examinations taken together will be placed in **SECOND CLASS**.

(iii) Those of the successful candidates who obtain 60% or more but less than 70% marks in the total of the aggregate of Semester-I to Semester-IV of LL.M. Examinations taken together will be placed in **FIRST CLASS**.

(iv) Those of successful candidates in First Class who obtains 70% or more of the total marks in the aggregate of Semester-1 to Semester-IV

of LL.M. Examination taken together will be placed in **FIRST CLASS with DISTINCTION.**

NOTE:

(1) For awarding University Gold Medal/s, performance of the Candidates in External University Examination shall only be considered and that the marks obtained in Practical/Project Papers/Courses and Dissertation shall not be taken into consideration.

(2) Candidates passing any Semester End Examination in compartments shall not become eligible for award of Gold Medal.

Rule. LL.M. 5: Syllabi Revision

(1) Syllabus of every paper/course shall be generally revised every three years.

(2) In a paper/course where units/topics/subject relates to government provisions, regulations legislations, enactments etc., such changes in the syllabi will be accommodated automatically by requisite resolutions through the Academic Bodies of the University and formally communicated to the Department of the University/respective P.G. Centres of the affiliated Colleges.

(3) Areas of new, additional and of contemporary relevance and courses of Elective Optional Groups of Specialization may be introduced through requisite resolutions by the University's competent academic bodies.

Rule LL.M. 5: Format of Question Paper

The Paper Setters are expected to follow the following format of question paper in accordance with the contents of the syllabus:

Question No. 1 to Question No. 4 25 marks for each question.

Write answer in detail. (With Internal Option)

Criticism Case Laws, etc (collectively)

Total 100 marks

Rule LL.M.-6: Dissertation and Practical Project Work

(1) The Dissertation shall be on one of the topics approved by the Committee of Post Graduate teachers teaching in the Department of the University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college as the case may be. The candidate will submit the same for approval to the Head of the Department of University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college not later than the beginning of the Second Semester. The Topic on which a candidate proposes to work for his/her Dissertation, an approval should normally be communicated to the candidate well in advance by the concerned Department of the University/P.G. Centre of the affiliated college.

(2) Two Copies of Dissertation shall be submitted in type written or printed format and One Copy each of the Practical/Project Work namely Doctrinal Research, Non-Doctrinal Research and Clinical Research report. The Doctrinal and Non-Doctrinal Research must be submitted in type written/printed format and Clinical Research Report may be submitted in Hand written format.

(3) A candidate desiring to appear at the LL.M. Semester-IV Examination shall have to submit his/her dissertation not later than 30th April of the respective academic year.

EDUCATIONAL CRITERIA & EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION INTO 3 YEAR LAW COURSE, 5 YEAR LAW COURSES

(1) Admission Eligibility:

- **Minimum Eligibility Criteria for admission in LL.B 3 Years Course:**

- 10+2+Graduate in Any discipline or equivalent with minimum 45% or equivalent CGPA for (General Category),
- 10+2+Graduate in Any discipline or equivalent with minimum 40% or equivalent CGPA for (SC and ST Category)
- 10+2+Graduate in Any discipline or equivalent with minimum 42% or equivalent CGPA for (SEBC Category)

Minimum Eligibility Criteria for admission in LL.B 5 Years (Integrated) Course:

- Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) with minimum 45% for (General Category),
- Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) with minimum 40% for (SC and ST Category)
- Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) with minimum 42% for (SEBC Category)

Minimum Eligibility Criteria for admission in LL.M 2 Years Course:

- Any Law Graduate (Five year integrated Law/LL.B Special)
(In three Groups Criminal Law, Business Law, Human Rights Law)

(2) Calculation of Merit:

Criminal Law Group, Business Law Group, Human Rights Group)

Merit:

Applicants must have applied in the prescribed time limit to GCAS. Applicants who are eligible for admission, GCAS prepare the list and send to concern college and Merit list frame by College.

General Rules:

- Minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a to get admission into an institution but only shall entitle the person concerned to fulfil other institutional criteria notified by the institution concerned or by the government concerned or Bar Council of India concerned from time to time to apply for admission.
- The qualifications of 10th, 12th (+2) and graduation may be obtained through any mode (distance/correspondence/open schooling method) is eligible for admission in LL.B. course.

(3) Reserved Seats:

- In order to take advantages of admission to any of the reservation category seats, the students shall have to submit the valid certificate for the concerned category form Competent Authority. The Reservation of seats shall be as follows:-

1	SC	7%
2	ST	15%
3	SEBC	27%
4	EWS	10%

1. In the admission list SC, ST. and O.B.C. If the category applicants are falling under general category then they will be admitted under general category as well as SC, ST. and O.B.C. Admission will be given to the place on which the category is selected. As such, they will not be entitled to the seat allotted as per general merit.

2. The seats will remain vacant due to lack of applicants from SC, ST category. will be filled from category applicants as well as ST. The seats will remain vacant due to lack of applicants from the category SC. will be filled from category applicants. However, SC And ST.

If the seats remain vacant due to lack of category applicants, those seats will be filled from general category.

3. Applicants who wish to avail reserved seat have to attach the caste or category certificate issued by the competent authority along with the application. Otherwise their application will be considered for general category seats only.

4. Applicants belonging to socially and educationally backward classes should attach a certificate of OBC issued by the competent authority and not included in the creamy layer category. It should be dated 01/04/2022 from the competent authority indicating that this certificate will be valid for three years or a certificate issued after that (it will be valid as per the limit mentioned in the certificate) otherwise their application will be considered only for general category seats.

5. Students belonging to economically backward non-reserved category will have to submit the certificate of the competent authority along with the application.

(3) Age of Admission :

- Subject to the condition stipulated by Bar Council of India.

The qualifications of 10th, 12th (+2) and graduation may be obtained through any mode (distance / correspondence / open schooling method) is eligible for admission in LL.B. course.

ADMISSION RULES

The Hemchandracharaya North Gujarat University Five Years' Integrated Law Programme Admission Rules, 2025

Short Title and Commencement

These rules shall be called the “**The Hemchandracharaya North Gujarat University Five Years' Integrated Law Admission Rules, 2025**”.

These rules shall be applicable for granting admission to the students in Semester I of the Five Years' Integrated LL.B. Programme for the academic year 2025-26. However, in the event of inconsistency between these rules and the instructions issued by the Education Department,

Government of Gujarat / authorized person on its behalf, the later shall prevail.

The Centers of Legal Education affiliated with Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University offer following

programmes in Five Years' Integrated Law Programme:

1. B.A.LL.B. (Five Years' Integrated);

2. B.Com.LL.B. (Five Years Integrated);

The aforesaid rules shall come into force from the April 1, 2025 and the earlier ordinances, rules and regulations contrary to these rules shall stand null and void for the program

Eligibility for Admission:-

1. For the purpose of admission, a candidate must have passed the qualifying examination in the subjects prescribed by respective education board from time to time from the

(i) Gujarat Board;

(ii) the Central Board of Secondary Education;

(iii) Any other board recognized and approved by the competent authority.

2. candidate who has passed the qualifying examination with minimum 45% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade shall be eligible for admission. The candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) and Schedules Tribes (ST) will be given exemption of 5% from the above criteria. (Minimum 40% for the candidates of SC and ST categories) and the candidate belonging to SEBC category will be given exemption of 3% (Minimum 42% for the candidate of SEBC Category);

Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a candidate to get admission in any of the Centre of Legal Education but shall only entitle the candidate concerned to fulfill basic criteria fixed by the Bar Council of India or other equivalent authority as well as the Gujarat University from time to time to apply for the admission.

3. A candidate who has passed the qualifying examination from Gujarat Board or Schools of Central Board in Gujarat State are not required to obtain Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) through online process from Hemchandracharaya North Gujarat University before registration.

4. Students coming from Boards other than mentioned in 6.3 above are mandatorily required to obtain Provisional Eligibility Certificate (PEC) by online process from Hemchandracharaya North Gujarat University website before registration through link www.hngu.ac.in website GCAS.

5. If a candidate has not passed SSC/HSC Examination from the board approved by the Government of Gujarat the Gujarat University shall have all the rights to refuse to grant Provisional Eligibility Certificate and admission of such candidate, if granted by any college shall automatically stand cancelled.

6. No student shall be allowed to simultaneously take admission and pursue for a law degree programme or any other programme with any other graduate or postgraduate or professional course run by the same or any other University or an Institute for academic or professional learning.

7. The maximum age for seeking admission is limited to 20 years as on 01.06.2024. However, in case of applicants from SC and ST categories the maximum age limit for seeking admission shall be 22 years as on 01.06.2024.

8. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of Theory marks obtained by a candidate in HSC Examination. However while ascertaining minimum eligibility criterion of a candidate, total marks (including Practical Marks) obtained by candidate in HSC exam will be considered. For the purpose of admission, the seats shall be reserved for the candidates who are of Gujarat origin and falling under the following categories and in following proportion, namely-

Reservation of Seats

Scheduled Castes: 7 %

Scheduled Tribes: 15%

Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC): 27%

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) 10% supernumerary as per BCI letter.

Candidates who have passed Qualifying Examination from other than Gujarat Board and Central Board School outside Gujarat State : 5%

Physically Handicapped (Physically disabled) persons : 5 % among all categories

A candidate seeking admission on reserved seat shall be required to produce a Certificate of Caste issued by the Competent Authority of the State of Gujarat. Provided that the candidate belonging to socially and Economically Backward Classes (SEBC) shall be required to produce a certificate issued by the Competent Authority stating that non-inclusion of candidate in Creamy Layer in addition to the caste certificate. Such Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued by the competent Authority shall be valid for Admission for the period of 3 years from the date of issuance or as notified by Government of Gujarat. No caste certificate shall be valid unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat. No certificate to the effect of non-inclusion in Creamy Layer shall be valid, unless it is duly stamped, signed and issued by the authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat.

If a candidate fails to upload the certificates of Caste/ Non Creamy Layer/ EWS as required within stipulated time, his/her candidature shall be considered for admission under unreserved

category. If a candidate of reserved category gets admission on unreserved seat in order of merits, he/she may be given admission on the unreserved seat according to his/her preference.

The admission of a candidate of a reserved category on a reserved seat shall be valid subject to the verification of caste certificate by the authority empowered by the State Government in this behalf. In case the caste certificate is found invalid on verification, he/she shall not have right to claim his/her admission on reserved seat and if he/she has already been granted admission, such admission shall be cancelled. Admission of such candidate may be continued

in case of availability of vacant unreserved seats, subject to the condition of eligibility of merit.

After granting admission to all the candidates of reserved categories on respective reserved seats, the vacant reserved category seats of Scheduled Caste (SC) (if any) shall be transferred to the seats of Scheduled Tribes (ST) and similarly, the vacant reserved category seats of Scheduled Tribe (ST) shall be transferred to the seats of Scheduled Caste (SC) by the Admission Committee after having obtained sanction from the competent authority of the Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University.

After having allotted admissions to all the candidates as mentioned in above, the remaining reserved category vacant seats (if any) shall be transferred to the seats of General Category by the Admission Committee after having obtained sanction from the competent authority of the Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University.

Reservation for Physically Disabled Candidates

5 % of the available seats in each category shall be reserved, in accordance with the provisions of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996), for the persons with disability who can perform the academic activities in the respective program. A candidate with disability shall have to upload certificate of disability issued and duly signed by the Civil Surgeon.

Explanation: “person with disability” means a person suffering from not less than 40% of any disability as certified by a competent medical authority.

Preparation of Merit List

The merit list of the candidates who have applied for admission in the manner prescribed by the Admission Committee, within the prescribed time limit and who are found eligible for admission under these rules, shall be prepared in the following manner subject to the instructions issued by the GCAS.

For the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from any of the Boards, percentage of aggregate marks obtained at H.S.C. Examination.

The criteria for deciding merit order in case of candidates having equal merit marks shall be

based on the following descending sequence, namely-

1. Aggregate marks obtained in qualifying examination - HSC
2. Aggregate marks of SSC Examination or equivalent examination
3. Date of Birth (Age) – Less age will be given priority

LL.B 3 Year Course Admission Rules

General Rules for the Programme:

A candidate has to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the State of Gujarat, UGC, Gujarat University, Bar Council of India, other competent authorities, and the concerned Centre of Legal Education.

The medium of instruction of the programme shall be in Gujarati and English. The Examination shall also be engaged in Gujarati and English language.

No candidate shall be permitted to pursue other Graduation or Post Graduation Programme run by the Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University or any other University or any courses run by the Professional Institutions as per the provisions of the Bar Council of India – Rules of Legal Education, 2008.

After having obtained admission in any of the Centre of Legal Education, if a candidate is caught indulging in ragging, his/her admission will be cancelled by the Centre of Legal Education and the Fees will not be refunded. The guilty candidate shall also be responsible for all the consequences arising out of ragging activities.

Preparation of Merit List

The merit list of the candidates who have applied for admission in the manner prescribed by the Admission Committee, within the prescribed time limit and who are found eligible for admission under these rules, shall be prepared in the following manner subject to the instructions issued by the GCAS.

Tie Breaker Criteria for Admission in UG and PG Courses:-

1 The candidate who wants to take admission in LL.B and LL.M courses if He/ She is stand in merit the same marks similar to other candidate then in such position the following rules can be apply:-

- a. The first rule is to compare their Last bachelor degree semester 5 & 6 marks which is higher aggregate marks.
- b. The second rule is to consider the 12th standard marks which is higher aggregate marks.
- c. The third rule is to consider the secondary 10th standard marks which is higher aggregate marks.
- d. The Fourth rule which is natural rule the Date of birth of candidate who born earlier in compare to other...
